BMP #102 Emergency Response: Outlines policies for reporting spills and medical emergencies.

BMP #202 Closed Container Policy: Requires that all containers of VOC-containing material remain closed when not in use.

BMP #203 Shrouding and #310 Over-Water Protection: Outline containment policies to prevent release of overspray or debris into the Bay.

BMP #401 Container Management Policy: Requires all containers to be clearly and correctly labeled as to contents. Containers must be maintained in good condition to prevent spills and leaks.

PROHIBITION AGAINST THINNING: Thinning of paint (addition of solvents) is prohibited at NASSCO.

RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENTS: Daily records of amounts and types of coatings applied at NASSCO must be maintained and submitted.

VOC LIMITS: APCD Rules specify maximum allowable VOC content for each coating activity. Use of compliant products is required at all times.

HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL: Employees have been made aware of applicable laws and NASSCO policies on proper disposal of hazardous waste.
