Subject: Coronavirus: Impacts to Supplier Visits to NASSCO Facilities

Dear Valued Supplier,

General Dynamics NASSCO is continually monitoring the state of affairs related to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and working to provide our supplier partners, customers, and employees with updates and guidance. As a valued supplier to NASSCO, we ask for your support in our efforts to prioritize health and safety during this time.

We request you carefully review all anticipated visits to NASSCO sites and/or facilities with your Supply Chain point of contact(s). Please consider the necessity of the visit and determine if it can occur virtually or telephonically. If our teams decide that an onsite meeting is necessary, please be mindful of the following:

Effective immediately and until further notice, NASSCO Security will begin screening visitors and prohibiting access for at least 14 days to those that answer "YES" to one, or more, of the following questions:

- 1) Have you, or anyone that you have had direct contact with been suspected of, or confirmed to have COVID-19?
- 2) Have you or anyone that you have had close contact with had an elevated temperature or respiratory symptoms, such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath, in the last 14 days?
- 3) Within the last 14 days have you, or someone in close contact with you, traveled to a CDC Level 3 country or high risk area of transmission?
  - i. These countries are (subject to change pending CDC updates):
    1. China
    2. Iran
    3. Italy
    4. South Korea

In addition to the questions above, if any of your employees have visited a NASSCO facility, and have since been confirmed or presumed to have COVID-19, you must notify us.

NASSCO Supply Chain Management will continue to communicate changes in policy and practice to our supplier community. In turn, we ask that you please continue to report potential COVID-19 related schedule delays and mitigation plans related to open Purchase Orders with your Supply Chain POCs.

This is a rapidly evolving situation and NASSCO appreciates your cooperation as we all strive to mitigate risk while we continue conducting business. Thank you for your continued support.
