Curious about what preventive screenings are right for you and your family?

Girls and Women

- Ages 11-12: The human papillomavirus (HPV)
 vaccine is recommended for protection from
 HPV, a virus that can cause cervical cancer
- Age 20: Begin annual visits with a gynecologist (visits should include a breast exam every 1-3 years)
- Age 21: Begin getting a Papanicolaou test (Pap smear) to screen for cervical cancer every three years
- Ages 40-50: Begin annual mammograms to detect early, treatable signs of breast cancer

Men

- Age 50: Ask your doctor about prostate cancer screenings and which test is right for you
- Ages 65-75: A one-time, abdominal aortic aneurysm screening ultrasound that looks for signs of an enlarged lower aorta which could lead to life-threatening internal bleeding

Children

- Regular pediatric check-ups and well-child visits to monitor growth and development
- Routine vaccinations

Both Men and Women

- Age 45: Begin colorectal cancer screenings for precancerous polyps or colorectal cancer
- Ages 65 and up: Bone density scans can detect risk for osteoporosis (brittle bones) or osteopenia (low bone mass)

All Ages

- Depression screening untreated depression can lead to a myriad of serious physical and mental complications
- Blood sugar test to check for prediabetes or diabetes varies based on risk factors
- Blood pressure test and cholesterol test to determine risk for heart disease and stroke

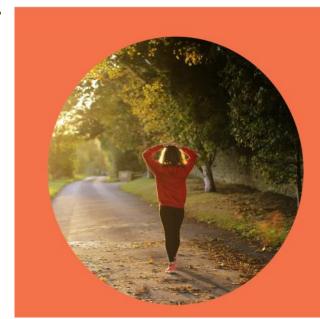

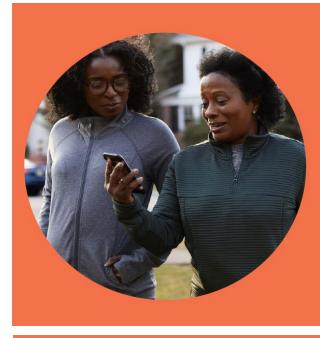

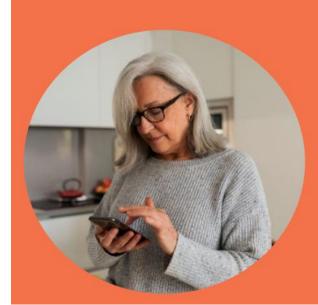
