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As cases of COVID-19 continue to rise, there have been a number of employees reporting they are being exposed by someone in their immediate household who has tested positive for the virus.

According to the CDC, individuals living with or providing care at home to someone who is positive for COVID-19 are at a high risk of incubating and becoming ill with the virus. If you are living with or providing care at home to someone who is positive for COVID-19, please do not come to work, contact your local public health authorities and your healthcare provider for instructions before returning to work. If you receive quarantine instructions, please call into the HR CV19 line (619) 544-8585 to report your absence and obtain leave information. After returning to work, if you develop any flu-like symptoms, immediately leave the NASSCO facility, notify your supervisor, contact your healthcare provider, and call the HR CV19 line.

Please continue to monitor your health, wear a mask, stay 6 feet from others, and wash your hands. It is important that all employees continue to stay diligent in following all safety protocols and guidelines to reduce the risk of exposure to COVID-19.

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
