SUBJECT: COVID-19 Update - NASSCO-San Diego Mask Guidance
FROM: NASSCO Human Resources

Based on the reopening of the State, as well as the recent guidelines from the CDC and Cal/OSHA, the following changes are effective immediately:

- **Face coverings are not required while working outdoors**
- **Face coverings are not required while working indoors if you are fully vaccinated**
- **For unvaccinated individuals, face coverings are still required when working indoors, except when alone in a room, eating and drinking at least 6 feet away from others, or when wearing a respirator necessary for the job**

* “Fully vaccinated” means it has been 14 days since receiving either the Johnson & Johnson vaccine or the second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines. Please submit a copy of your vaccination card to the Medical Department.

Additionally, N95 masks are available for voluntary use for all employees.

Face Covering Protocols

	Indoor Work Areas <small>(areas with an overhead and four enclosed sides. Ex: interior spaces of buildings, office trailers, blocks, ships or vehicles)</small>	Outdoor Work Areas <small>(areas with no overhead and good natural ventilation or indoor areas with one or more sides fully opened. Ex: hanger bays, well decks or B&P cells with one side fully opened, BAL, Bldg 44 Repair Shop)</small>
Vaccinated <small>(2 weeks after the second dose in a 2-dose series or a single-dose vaccine)</small>	 Face coverings NOT required <small>(proof of vaccination must be provided to NASSCO Medical)</small>	 Face coverings NOT required
Unvaccinated	 Face coverings are REQUIRED except when: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Alone in a room, vehicle or at workstation with partitions• Eating and drinking at least six feet away from others or at tables with partitions• Wearing respirators as necessary for the job	 Face coverings NOT required
