SUBJECT: COVID-19 Update: NASSCO-San Diego Updated Face Covering Guidance

Due to the recent increase of COVID-19 cases, and in our continued effort to ensure the safety and well-being of our workforce, we are adjusting the facial covering requirement, effective Monday, August 16. All employees, regardless of vaccination status, will be required to wear a face covering while indoors. This includes on board ships and all areas with an overhead and four enclosed sides (e.g. interior spaces of buildings, office trailers, blocks, ships and vehicles). Please review the below revised NASSCO face covering protocols flyer, which reflects these changes.



'Face covering' means a surgical mask, a respirator worn voluntarily (e.g. N95/KN95), or a fabric material of at least two layers. N95/KN95 masks are available at any NASSCO tool room in the shipyard. Mission Valley personnel can go to their department managers.

Face coverings must be clean, undamaged and worn over the nose and mouth. Scarfs, face shields, ski masks, balaclavas, sock hoods, bandanas, gaiters, or any single layer of fabric are not acceptable forms of face covering.

Face Covering Protocols

Effective 8/16/2021

Indoor Work Areas Areas with an overhead and four enclosed sides (e.g. interior spaces of buildings, office trailers, blocks, ships or vehicles)	Outdoor Work Areas Areas with no overhead and good natural ventilation or indoor areas with one or more sides fully opened (e.g. hangar bays, well decks or B&P cells with one side fully opened, BAL, Bldg 44 Repair Shop)
 <p>Face coverings are REQUIRED except when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Alone in a room, vehicle or at workstation with partitions• Eating and drinking at least six feet away from others or at tables with partitions• Wearing respirators as necessary for the job <p>• ACCEPTABLE face coverings: surgical masks, fabric material of at least two layers, or respirators worn voluntarily (ex: N95/KN95, P100)</p> <p>• UNACCEPTABLE face coverings: scarfs, face shields, ski masks, balaclavas, sock hoods, bandanas, gaiters, or any single layer of fabric</p>	 <p>Face coverings NOT required</p>
