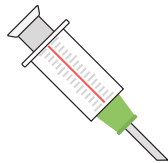

Frequently Asked Questions

1. **When is the event?**

The event will take place on Friday, October 15, from 7 a.m. - 1 p.m.

2. **Where is the vaccination event happening?**

The event will take place at General Dynamics NASSCO in front of the Gate 6 Entrance (Intersection of Harbor and 28th). Visit nassco.com/events for specific parking directions and details.

3. **Who can attend?**

The community, shipyard workers, and shipyard contractors.

4. **What do I need to bring on the day of the event?**

Photo ID and vaccination card if you're eligible to receive your second COVID-19 vaccine or booster shot.

5. **What vaccine options are available at the event?**

Champions for Health is offering the recently FDA approved Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, single-dose Johnson & Johnson/Janssen, Pfizer-BioNTech Boosters and flu vaccines.

6. **Who is eligible for the vaccinations?**

The Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine is available for individuals 12 years of age and older.

The Moderna vaccine is available for individuals 18 years of age and older.

The Johnson & Johnson/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine is available for individuals 18 years of age and older.

The flu vaccine is available for individuals 3 years of age and older.

*Minors who would like to receive the flu and Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or have a signed consent form as well as a photo ID and documentation to show proof of age.

7. **What other resources will be available on October 15?**

Tuberculosis risk assessments.

8. **When will the second shot be administered?**

Champions for Health will return on Friday, November 12, to administer the second dose of Pfizer and Moderna to individuals who received their first dose on October 15.

9. **Can I receive my second dose at this event if I received my first dose somewhere else?**

Yes, as long as you are eligible to receive your second dose. Visit www.cdc.gov to check your eligibility.

10. **Will the Pfizer-BioNTech booster be available?**

The booster shot will be available for eligible individuals who have completed their initial series at least 6 months from October 15. Visit www.cdc.gov to check your eligibility.
