Subj: STATE OF CALIFORNIA EXECUTIVE ORDER N-33-20 OF MARCH 19, 2020

- 1. Under the State of California Executive Order N-33-20 of March 19, 2020, all individuals living in the State of California were directed to stay home or at their place of residence.
- 2. The prohibition does not apply to individuals needed to maintain continuity of operations of the federal critical infrastructure sectors outlined at https://www.cisa.gov/critical-infrastructure-sectors, which includes the Defense Industrial Base Sector. The Defense Industrial Base Sector is the worldwide industrial complex that enables research and development, as well as design, production, delivery, and maintenance of military weapons systems, subsystems, and components or parts, to meet U.S. military requirements. The Defense Industrial Base includes Defense Industrial Base companies and their subcontractors and suppliers who perform under contract to the Department of Defense.
- 3. The Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) is the Department of the Navy's system command responsible for designing, building, delivering, and maintaining Navy ships and systems that are critical to the national defense. It is my determination, as the CNRMC/SEA21, that your contractual efforts in the State of California are needed to maintain continuity of operations of the Defense Industrial Base Sector in support of NAVSEA's mission to maintain Navy ships and systems. Accomplishing this includes all business, activities, and travel necessary to support NAVSEA's mission. Under the terms of the State of California Executive Order N-33-20 of March 19, 2020, you have authority to continue performance of your contract(s).
